

On February 17th, tell Congress: **Finish reform now and finish reform right.**

Your Member of Congress works for you. On February 17th, join thousands of Americans across the country in calling on Congress to finish reform now and finish reform right.

What to do:

- **Locate your Member of Congress' District office.** Members of Congress will be in their district offices the week of February 15th for Presidents' Day recess. Look up their District addresses on their web pages. It's usually at the bottom of the main page or under the Contact tab.
 - If there are several District offices near you, call the main district office and ask which office the Member will be in on February 17th.
- **Recruit friends** for your February 17th visit!

What to say:

When you get to the Member's office, ask to speak to the Member of Congress. If he/she isn't there, ask if there's anyone else you can speak to about health care. Tell them:

- I care about health care reform.
- We need health care reform because. . . .(tell a brief personal story or other reasons our broken health care system affects you.)
- These problems haven't gone away. Congress needs to **finish the job** to provide quality, affordable health care for all.
- Congressional leaders and the President should figure out a way to do this so health care is affordable and our health care benefits aren't taxed.
- Important improvements must be made to the Senate bill. They should be done by simple majority. Those improvements are necessary for the bill to be signed into law.
- **Specific ask:** I'm asking you to stand up and publicly say you support finishing health care reform right.
